

Elm Grove Memorial Day Parade

Participation Rules

Purpose: To Commemorate and Celebrate those individuals who have served and those presently serving in the Armed Forces of the United States of America.

2012 Theme: Land that I Love!

1. The participants should adhere to, and serve the purpose of the parade. As such, all signs and handouts must fall in line with the purpose of the parade. For example, "Penelope's Restaurant Honors Those Who Have Served This Country" would be an allowed sign. "Come Eat at Penelope's Restaurant" would not be allowed. The parade Committee reserves the right to make the final decision regarding this matter.
2. Participants should notify the parade chairperson at least two weeks prior to the parade if they will not be in the parade or they have special requests. This includes any need for a vehicle.
3. There will be no throwing of anything from the street to the audience. You may walk along the side of the road and HAND OUT candy, etc. This includes candy, souvenirs, etc. This is due to the safety of the parade watchers. We do not want children running into the street to collect the handouts.
4. Participants must report to the parade site at the agreed upon time prior to the start of the parade.
5. There will be many excited children on parade day. They frequently dart out into the street. PLEASE remember to use extra caution while driving!
6. There will be no use of tape to attach signs to cars. Use soft pliable magnets or recruit someone to carry a sign for you. Attaching signs to cars is at the discretion of the owner of the car.
